DSPs must be reliable and responsible to provide high quality care, and be creative and caring individuals who are willing to go above and beyond to help their participants grow.

ACES is hiring for part-time and full-time hours in Lexington, Winchester, Versailles, and Georgetown. Hours are based on participant needs and available mornings, evenings, and weekends. Wages and benefits are competitive and based on experience.

Requirements:

- Eighteen (18) years old and has a high school diploma or GED; OR
- Twenty-one (21) years old;
- Has the ability to:
 - Maintain participant health, safety, and welfare;
 - Communicate effectively;
 - Read, understand, and implement written and oral instructions;
 - Perform required documentation; and
 - Work both independently and as part of a team;
- Valid driver's license, reliable operating transportation, and proof of current auto insurance
